Members within and around these areas are encouraged to participate and support these programmes prayerfully and physically.

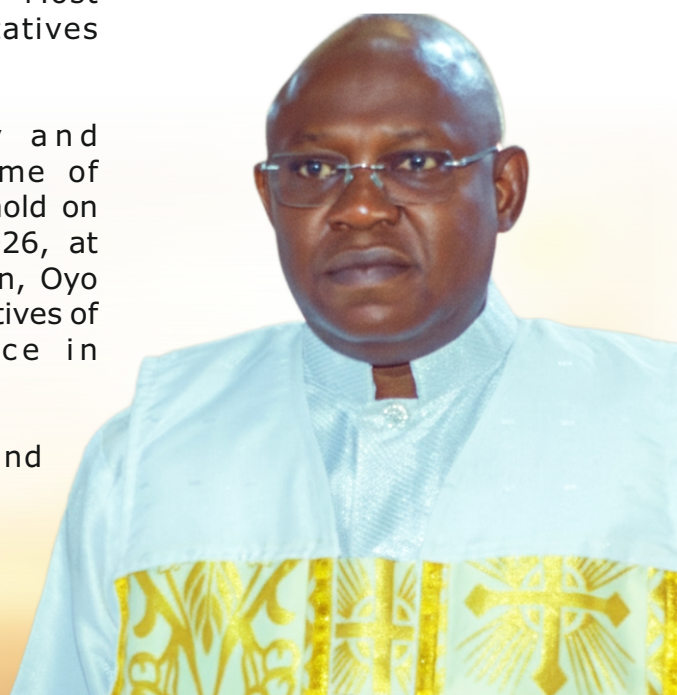
**OUR COLLECTIVE CHARGE**

# WHO IS CARRYING THE LOAD AT HOME?

Come closer... yes, you.

Let's talk.

You are welcome to another Edition of \_Let's Talk With King Samba Spirit.\_

If you are sitting right here in front of me now, I will ask you one simple question, In your home, who is carrying the burden?\*

Be honest.

Is it just the man?

Is it just the woman?

Or are both of you truly working together?

Because the truth is, things are not the way they used to be.

The same salary is coming in, but it is not doing the same work anymore. Prices have changed. Responsibilities have increased. And quietly, pressure has entered many homes.

Now let me say this clearly, this is not the time to leave everything for one person.
